headspace Health Space (Youth Clinic)



What can you expect from the headspace Youth Clinic:

The **headspace** Youth Clinic operates within the **headspace** Dandenong Centre and provides health care for young people aged 12-25 years by youth-friendly doctors and nurses.

Services include:

- General health care for any issue
- Health checks
- Health test e.g. blood tests and scans
- Immunisations (vaccinations)
- Sexual Health e.g. pregnancy related, contraception, STI testing

Appointments

We use an appointment based system. Appointments can be made over the phone or in person.

For opening hours call 1800 367 68

After hours (Medical care when the Youth Clinic is closed)

- Call or visit your regular doctor
- Call the Home visiting Doctor Service (13SICK) on 13 74 25
- If it is a medical emergency, call 000 or attend your local hospital Emergency Department

Costs:

Doctors consults are free (bulk billed) with a valid Medicare card. Nurse consults are free and do not require a Medicare card. Tests, procedures, x-rays or medications may incur a cost.
